

Inglewood is coming out of Retirement

Many of you may already be aware of the recent activity on the site of Inglewood, the former Champneys luxury spa and health hydro in Kintbury. The site, which was purchased by Audley in June 2005 has been empty and neglected for some time. The planning stages are now complete and work has begun to restore Inglewood to its former glory. The prestigious scheme will consist of 96 stylish retirement properties set in 36 acres of picturesque grounds. The main house will be restored and will also accommodate an elegant Club House. Other facilities will include a restaurant, coffee lounge and bar, croquet lawn, swimming pool, gym, and treatment rooms.

Inglewood has a long history. It was first mentioned in the Doomsday Book and the mansion itself dates back to the late 18th century. In 1929 it was renamed St John's College, and for nearly 50 years became the provincial headquarters of the De La Salle Brothers, before becoming part of the Champneys Group.

A new chapter in Inglewood's history is about to begin. Audley recognises that by committing to this programme, it will become an integral part of the local community. The aim is to keep local people informed at all stages of the renovation programme and beyond, and your views are welcome. The first homes will be released for sale in late summer when there will be a sales and marketing suite on the site.
